



**Newfoundland Adventure Tour**  
**August 26<sup>th</sup> to September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017**  
**7 nights and 8 days**

**Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> Day 1 Fly to St. John's, NL**

All Day Depart from Halifax International Airport (or other Maritime cities \$\$) and arrive at the St. John's International Airport. Meet your Tour Director and Driver and **transfer to the Quality Inn St. John's.**

Evening Enjoy dinner on your own. The rest of the evening is on your own to explore the downtown area.

**Sunday, August 27<sup>th</sup> Day 2 St. John's Tour (B, D)**

Morning Enjoy a complimentary breakfast and meet with your Tour Director. Today we meet our **step-op guide for a tour of St. John's.** We will spend the **morning visiting Signal Hill and Cape Spear.** Signal Hill is a historic site that celebrates the rich communications and military history. While on the hill you might wish to walk to the lookout trail. Cabot Tower is located on the summit of Signal Hill. Cape Spear has the oldest surviving lighthouse in North America. It has been restored to its 1839 appearance and shows how a light keeper and family might have lived in the mid 19th century.

Afternoon The afternoon will be spent strolling historic St. John's.

Evening The evening, join us for a **"Welcome to Atlantic Canada" Dinner at The Keg Restaurant.**

**Monday, August 28<sup>th</sup> Day 3 St. John's to Gander (B)**

Morning Enjoy a **complimentary hot breakfast** and meet your tour director. This morning we check out and depart for Gander. On the way we **visit the historic town of Bonavista.** When Italian explorer John Cabot first discovered North America in 1497, his first words were "O buono vista!". When translated into English, this phrase means, "Oh happy sight!". We will **visit Ryan Premises** for an excellent look at how Canada's East Coast cod fishery operated for almost a century.

Afternoon This afternoon, we **visit the community of Trinity.** Locally known as "Trinity Bight" of Newfoundland, houses, museums, art galleries, and other historic buildings preserved from the 18th century, fill Trinity and its surrounding communities.

Evening We arrive at **Sinbad's Hotel in Gander** and check in. Dinner is on your own tonight.

**Tuesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> Day 4 Tour Twillingate (B, D)**

Morning Enjoy a **complimentary breakfast** and meet with your Tour Director. We depart for the coastal town of Twillingate, the iceberg capital of the world. We arrive at Pier 52 and board the **MV Iceberg Quest for a boat tour** of majestic icebergs that have calved from the glaciers of Greenland. You may also see 40 tonne humpback whales on your ocean quest. We return to the pier and have lunch. (not included)

Afternoon After lunch, we travel to **Auk Island Winery**. Auk Island Winery is named in remembrance of the Great Auk that became extinct in 1844. It was the original Penguin and was found in great numbers around Notre Dame Bay and the Funk Islands. Next we visit **Long Point Lighthouse**, one of the most photographed landmarks on the Northeast Coast of Newfoundland; it is located at Crow Head, Twillingate. More than 300 feet above sea level, this is a lookout point where thousands of visitors every year enjoy the panoramic view of the Atlantic Ocean.

Evening Enjoy **dinner at the hotel** and explore the local sights in Gander

**Wednesday, August 30<sup>th</sup> Day 5 Gander to Deer Lake (B, D)**

Morning Enjoy a **complimentary breakfast** and meet your tour director. This morning we travel to community of Lewisport and **visit By the Bay Museum & Craft Shop**. Overlooking the water in the heart of Lewisport, the By the Bay Craft Shop is located in the historic premises of the West End School.

Afternoon After lunch, we stop in Grand Falls-Windsor at the **Salmonid Interpretation Centre**, located on the Exploits River and one of the largest Atlantic Salmon enhancement projects in North America. After our visit, we travel to Rocky Harbour and enjoy the scenic beauty and landscape of central Newfoundland. Later this afternoon we check in to the **Holiday Inn Express Deer Lake**.

Evening Tonight we will enjoy **dinner in the local restaurant** followed by an **Bon Tours evening cruise** with live music & refreshments on the waters of Bonne Bay. A pleasant ride on a catamaran with stunning scenery and magical sunsets is the perfect conclusion to a day in the park.

**Thursday, August 31<sup>st</sup> Day 6 Tour Gros Morne (B, L)**

Morning/  
Afternoon Enjoy a **complimentary breakfast** and meet your tour director. This morning we travel to Rocky Harbour for a **full day guided tour** of the North side of **Gros Morne National Historic Site**. Highlights include Norris Point Look-off, Lobster Cove Head Lighthouse and the Parks Canada Interpretation Centre. We will have an **included lunch** on the tour.

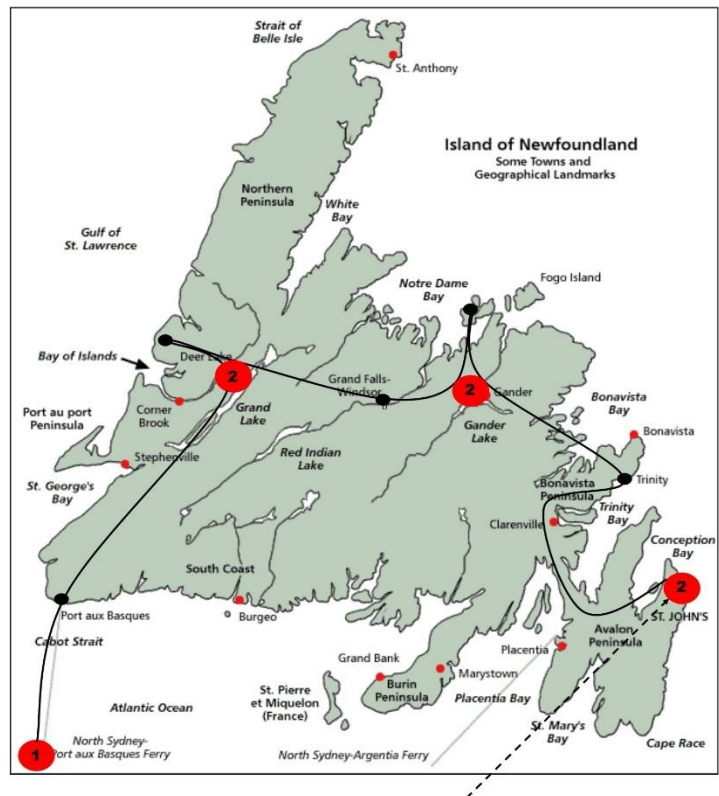
Evening Enjoy an dinner on your own tonight (not included) and explore Deer Lake.

The Highland Village Museum is an outdoor living history museum that tells the story of Gaelic settlement in Nova Scotia. We are located on a stunning 43-acre property overlooking the majestic Bras d'Or Lakes in Iona, Nova Scotia.
- Afternoon** This afternoon we visit **Rita's Tea Room** for an **included lunch**. After lunch, we travel to Charlottetown. We will stop in Truro for transfers to Halifax and Aulac for transfers to Moncton and Fredericton.
- Evening** We arrive back in Charlottetown with many happy memories of your **8-day Newfoundland Adventure Tour**. Say goodbye to your driver and Tour Director from Target Tours.
