Summary Itinerary

Tuesday, October 29th

Day 1

Portsmouth, NH

Meet your **Driver** and **Tour Director** and depart on your **Salem & Boston Halloween Tour**. We begin in Charlottetown this morning with pick up in Borden, Aulac, Salisbury, Lincoln, and Woodstock along the way. Transfers are available from Halifax, Dartmouth, Truro, and Saint John. We will stop for lunch (not included) at the Acorn Restaurant in Lake George, NB.

Arrive at our host hotel this evening, the **Hampton Inn & Suites Portsmouth Central** in Portsmouth, NH. The complimentary hotel shuttle can provide transportation to nearby shopping and restaurants.

Wednesday, October 30th

Day 2

Salem, MA

Enjoy a **complimentary breakfast** and meet with your Tour Director. This morning we will travel to Salem, MA. Upon arrival in Salem will be joined by a **Local Guide** to begin our tour of this bewitching seaport. Our tour will include the rich maritime and literary history as well as the infamous witchcraft hysteria of 1692, and a walk through the **Witch Trial Memorial**. Next, we will travel to the coastal town of **Marblehead**. With its crooked streets and seaside mansions Marblehead is a town rich with colonial history. Our tour will include a stop at **Castle Rock** on Marblehead Neck, where we can take pictures of the beautiful rocky coast, and a visit to **Abbot Hall** to view Archibald Williard's original painting "Spirit of 76" (pending availability).

After lunch (not included) this afternoon we will continue to explore Salem. First, we will visit the **1692 Salem Witch Museum** where we will experience the drama of that dark time through thirteen life-size stage sets, figures, lighting and a stirring narration as they are witness to the web of lies and intrigue of the Salem Witch Hunt. Next, you are free to spend time exploring the town on your own. You may wish to visit The House of the Seven Gables, The Witch House, or other points of interest.

This evening we will enjoy an **included dinner** at a local restaurant before returning to our hotel in Portsmouth, NH. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

Thursday, October 31st

Day 3

Boston, MA

Enjoy a **complimentary breakfast** and meet with your Tour Director. This morning we will travel to Boston, MA. Once we arrive in Boston we will be met by a **Local Guide**. Faneuil Hall, the Old State House, King's Chapel, Old Granary Burial Ground, site of the Boston Massacre, and Beacon Hill are all highlighted as your guide relates the history, folklore and current events of Boston. A walk through the North End will introduce you to one of Boston's oldest and most historic neighbourhoods with the Paul Revere House.

This afternoon following our tour we will stop at Faneuil Hall Marketplace and Quincy Market for lunch (not included) and free time to explore the shops. We will then travel to **Wrentham Village Premium Outlets** for time for shopping.

We arrive back in Portsmouth this evening for free time to explore the nearby shops and have dinner (not included) at a local restaurant.
