Friday, September 24th

Day 1

Flight to Dublin

Depart from select Maritime cities (Charlottetown, Halifax, Moncton, or Fredericton) on your overnight flight to Dublin. Try and get some sleep before your morning arrival. A light meal and breakfast will be served on board the flight.

A Cead Mile Failte to the Emerald Isle is extended on arrival Dublin Airport by your Driver-Guide before a short drive takes us to the Man 'O War traditional Irish pub. Afterwards we travel on to our hotel to relax and unwind before an early dinner.



Culloden Estate & Spa



Standing high on the slopes of the Holywood Hills, overlooking Belfast Lough and the County Antrim Coastline, is the magnificent Culloden Estate and Spa, the most prestigious luxury five star hotel in Northern Ireland. Activity Level

Travelling with Target Tours requires a certain level of activity in order to enjoy and participate in our tours.

- Walking or standing for extended periods of time

Therefore, all travellers must be able to manage their mobility independently.

The suggested industry guideline is 4 to 6 EUR per person, per day for your Tour Director and also your Driver.
