# Summary Itinerary

## Day 1 - April 27, 2026

Depart of your **overnight flight** to **Rome**. (IFM)

## Day 2 - April 28, 2026

Welcome to Rome! Meet your **guide** and transfer to the city center. After lunch, enjoy a **historic walking tour** from **Piazza Navona**, visiting landmarks like **Bernini's Fountain**, **Trevi Fountain**, **Spanish Steps**, and **Piazza di Spagna**. (L, D)



## Day 3 - April 29, 2026

Meet your guide for a visit of the **inside of the Colosseum**. Depart Rome for the **Orvieto region**, stopping for lunch along the way. Enjoy a **guided tour of Civita di Bagnoregio** including an entrance ticket. (B, L, D)

## Day 4 - April 30, 2026

Visit an **organic farm** growing cereals like durum wheat, spelt, and soft wheat, along with orchards, a hazelnut grove, and olive groves. The farm has its own oil mill and bottling facility. Enjoy lunch at the farm before heading to **Orvieto**. Take a funicular to the historic center and explore this charming hilltop town. (B, L, D)



## Day 5 - May 1, 2026

Depart for **Montepulciano**. Stroll its charming streets, explore **Piazza Grande**, and admire historic churches before enjoying lunch paired with wines in a local winery. Continue to **Montalcino**. Wander its historic streets, visit the imposing Fortezza, and soak in breathtaking views. Later afternoon arrival at your **Italian Farm Stay**. (B, L, D)

## Day 6 - May 2, 2026

Visit to a **family-run dairy** for a tasting of pecorino cheeses, paired with marmalade, honey, water, and Rosso di Montepulciano wine. A dairy expert will guide you through the tasting and share insights into the production process. Enjoy a **guided tour of Pienza**, the 'ideal city' by Pope Pius II. Stroll through **Piazza Pio II**, admire the cathedral, and enjoy stunning views of **Val d'Orcia**. Continue to **Bagno Vignoni**, a unique spa village with a thermal pool in the main square. Enjoy free time to explore. (B, L, D)



# Summary Itinerary

## Day 7 - May 3, 2026

Enjoy a **guided visit to Siena**, a city full of medieval charm and history. Stroll through its medieval streets, admire the **Piazza del Campo**, famous for the **Palio horse race**, the majestic **Duomo di Siena**, and the elegant **Palazzo Pubblico**. Continue to **Montecatini**. (B, L, D)

## Day 8 - May 4, 2026

Take a short walk to the **Montecatini train station** for a **scenic 1-hour ride to Florence**. Upon arrival, meet your **guide for a tour of the historical center**.

Enjoy **free time** for lunch. We recommend visiting the central market for local specialties, such as lampredotto sandwich. The afternoon is free to explore before returning to Montecatini by train. (B, D)

## Day 9 - May 5, 2026

Explore the renowned **nursery in Pistoia**, Italy's plant cultivation capital. Learn about sustainable growing techniques and admire collections of ornamental and Mediterranean species.

Continue to **Pisa for lunch** and a visit to **Pisa Square**. Travel to **Lucca** and explore this well-preserved walled city with your guide. Wander medieval streets, admire **Piazza dell'Anfiteatro**, visit **San Michele**, and stroll along the Renaissance walls. Enjoy a dinner at **Fattoria Il Poggio**, paired with farm wines and olive oils. (B, L, D)

## Day 10 - May 6, 2026

Travel from **Montecatini to Venice**. You'll stop along the way near **Bologna** to visit a **cheese factory** and learn about the stages of Parmigiano Reggiano production. Enjoy a tasting of differently aged Parmigiano Reggiano.

Continue to **Venice/Mestre** for the next two-night stay. (B, L, D)

## Day 11 - May 7, 2026

Transfer to **Venice's Historic Centre** and meet your guide in San Marco Square for a **two-hour tour of the city's landmarks**. Highlights include **San Marco Square and Basilica** (viewed from the outside), **Palazzo Ducale**, the **Bridge of Sights**, and the **Belltower**.

Then, enjoy **free time to explore Venice** at your own pace. In the evening, enjoy a **farewell dinner at a traditional Trattoria**. (B, D)
