### Day 1 - May 1, 2026

Depart on your direct overnight flight to **Amsterdam**.

### Day 2 - May 2, 2026

Arrive in Amsterdam and meet your local guide and driver. Depart for the Sassenheim Region and stop for an **included lunch along the way**. This afternoon visit a **local tulip farm**. (IFM, L, D)

### Day 3 - May 3, 2026

Travel to Giethoorn for an **included lunch** and **scenic boat tour** through its picturesque canals. Continue to the Twente region, and enjoy an **included dinner**. (B, L, D)

### Day 4 - May 4, 2026

Begin the day with a **tour and tasting at a cheese-producing dairy farm**. After an **included lunch**, visit the **Arnhem Airborne Museum** and the **Holten Canadian War Cemetery**, where you can join a silent WWII remembrance march. Later, enjoy **dinner** with the group. (B, L, D) *Note: today's schedule is subject to change based on memorial program which is still to be announced.*

### Day 5 - May 5, 2026

Travel to **Farm Nescio** in Bleskensgraaf for a tour highlighting **innovative technology, a skybox view over the cows, and a farm lunch**. Continue to **Kinderdijk** to see the **iconic windmills**, then travel to Rotterdam for a **tour of Europe's largest port**. (B, L, D)

### Day 6 - May 6, 2026

Start the day with a **city tour of Breda**, then visit **Natuurlijk Klein Dongen** for a greenhouse farm tour, regional product shop, and a delicious **lunch made from fresh, local ingredients**. Enjoy **free time** in Breda before **dinner** this evening. (B, L, D)

### Day 7 - May 7, 2026

Begin the journey back to Amsterdam with a stop at an **eel smokehouse** for a **tour and lunch**. Enjoy **free time** in both Volendam and Amsterdam before dinner this evening. (B, L, D)
